Selecting electricity supplier for installations in new buildings

General terms

All customers must select an electricity supplier before a meter can be connected to their installation, or before they can be connected to the grid and receive power. The customer can select an electricity supplier on the website **www.elpris.dk.**

Please follow these steps in order to receive power to an address:

- 1. Register the address (this is done by the electrical contractor)
- Select an electricity supplier, for example at the website www.elpris.dk (this is done by the building owner if the installation is in a new building)
- **3.** Connect the meter to the installation (the electrical contractor makes an appointment with Radius).

Building owner's responsibility

If the end customer has not yet moved into the building, the building owner is responsible for registering the address's installation number with an electricity supplier. The building owner can assign this responsibility to a third party via power of attorney.

When the building owner has selected an electricity supplier, the meter can be connected.
